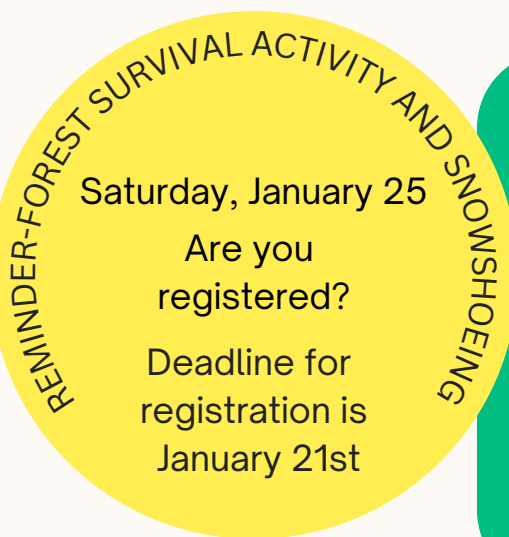
Respect hiking trail signage
