A shared commitment to alleviate 9-1-1 congestion

- To make a non-emergency report to your municipality 24/7;
 - For issues on municipal roads, such as potholes, defective streetlights, slippery roads, etc., please dial 3-1-1.
- Your call will be forwarded to municipal staff.



You must dial 9-1-1 in these cases:

- An emergency is in progress (fight, robbery, accident);
- You have been the victim of a crime (theft from a residence, fraud, assault);
- A life is in danger (sick person, armed individual);
- You want to report a fire.



2025 Boat Stickers

The 2025 boat stickers will be mailed to you with the invoice at the beginning of May.

New rates

Boats with motors of less than 25 added horsepower or 25 kW

The fee per boat is \$50

Boats with motors of 25 added horsepower or 25 kW or more and personal watercraft

The fee per boat is \$100

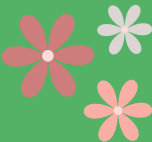
